time, wasn't it?



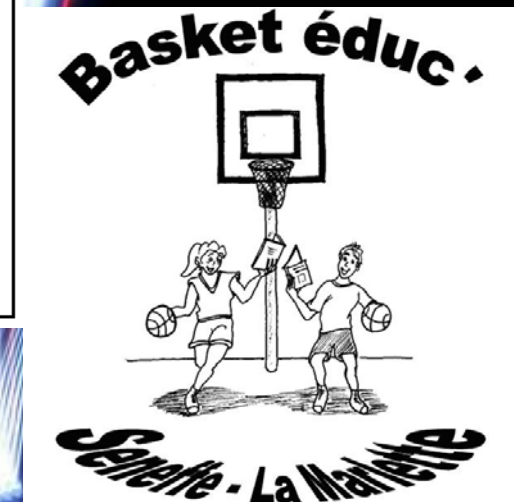
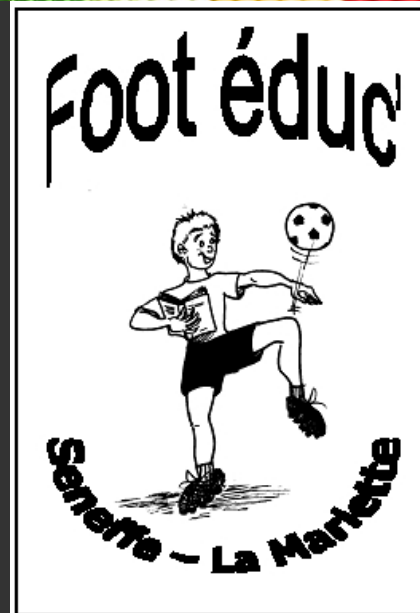
So Sport éducatif is a school...
